The Three Conferences Fact Sheet

Remember what happened by BUGS GREW BREAD and ARGUE.

Tehran Conference, November-December 1943

The Allied Powers decided that: (BUGS)

- 1. **B**ritain and America would invade Nazi-controlled France.
- 2. United Nations Organization would be established after the war.
- 3. Generals and military staff would keep in close touch with each other.
- 4. Stalin would fight Japan once Germany was defeated.

Yalta Conference, February 1945

The Allied Powers decided to: (GREW)

- 1. Germany was to be divided into 4 zones that the Allies would occupy after the war.
- 2. **R**ussia would join the United Nations.
- 3. European countries freed by the Allies would be democratic and independent.
- 4. War criminal trials set up to try Nazi leaders.

Potsdam Conference, July-August 1945

The Allied Powers decided to: (BREAD)

- 1. Ban the Nazi Party and all Nazi laws.
- 2. Reduce Germany's size by 25% compared to its 1937 borders.
- 3. Establish the four-part division of Germany into British, French, US and Soviet Zones.
- 4. Allow Russia to take reparations (fines) from the Soviet Zone of Germany.
- 5. **D**estroy all factories producing military goods in Germany.

Disagreements at Potsdam (ARGUE)

The Allied Powers disagreed on: (ARGUE)

- 1. Arrest of non-Communist Polish leaders by Stalin
- 2. Reparations to be paid Stalin wanted more
- 3. Germany's future Stalin wanted to cripple it, Truman wanted to help it recover
- 4. USA's secret atomic bomb that Stalin found out about
- 5. Eastern European Communists coming to power
