 - 4-6 marks Developed statement (a developed statement is a simple statement with additional supporting material or explanation). 4 marks for one developed statement, 5 marks for two developed statements, and 6 marks for three developed statements.
- (b) Explain why ... (12)
 - 1-3 marks Simple or generalised statements of causation. 1 mark per point up to a maximum of three.
 - 4-9 marks Explains why causes led to the event,
 - ♦ 4–5 marks for one developed argument.
 - ♦ 6–7 marks for two developed arguments
 - ♦ 8–9 marks for three developed arguments or more
 - 10-12 marks As level 2 plus event,
 - ♦ 10–11 marks for linking OR prioritising factors
 - ♦ 11–12 marks linking AND prioritising factors.
